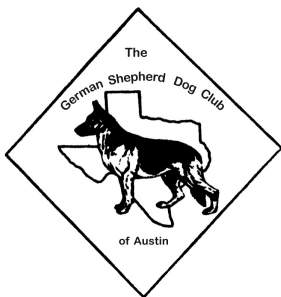

### **Beginner Puppies (4-6 months of age)** **AKC Sanctioned Beginner Puppy Competition**

The GSDC of Austin and the GSDC of San Antonio will be offering as a special attraction the 4-6 month puppy class. There will be a selection of Best Beginner Puppy and Best of Opposite Sex.

Dogs are required to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol in order to avoid inadvertent transmission of illness by/to puppies not yet fully immunized.

*AKC Rules in Dealing with Misconduct* will be applicable to any person and dog entered at this competition. All applicable rules found in *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* will govern the conduct of this competition unless these regulations state otherwise.

The entry fee for this class is \$12.00. Use the regular AKC entry form to enter this class. An AKC registration number or litter number will be required. The class will be judged during the break between dogs and bitches. Winners of these classes are not eligible to compete in the winners classes for dogs and bitches. Entries will be taken from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at the Show Secretary's table.

### **Non-Regular Classes**

**VETERAN** – A class for dogs and a class for bitches seven years of age or older. The winners of these classes will be eligible to compete in the Best of Breed Competition.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

**NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a Licensed or member show.

**NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**NOVICE SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**OPEN JUNIOR CLASS** - For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have one three first places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS** - For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the date of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**OPEN SENIOR CLASS** - For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Junior Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

## ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

### GENERAL

- Canadian exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U. S. accounts or with international money order in U.S. funds.
- You may now enter this show on line using PayPal. To submit your on-line entry(ies), go to [www.BleakneyShowServices.com](http://www.BleakneyShowServices.com) and click on "Enter A Show". Just follow the directions on that page. There is also a clank AKC entry form for your use on the same page. If you don't have a PayPal account, it is easy to set one up. Just go to [www.PayPal.com](http://www.PayPal.com), click on "Sign Up" and follow the directions. There are no sign-up fees.
- There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- Dogs need be present for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Club nor its Show Secretary will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.
- The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes, or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary.
- Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a Championship after the closing of entries, but whose Championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular judging.

- The show-giving club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children while attending these shows.
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.
- Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in). Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed, The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed, The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 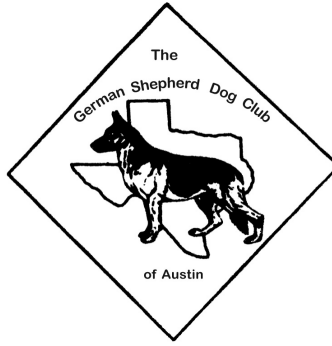
